


KSSS - Our Purpose


Switch 4 Schools

Students are able to safely check in each day to let the teacher know how they are feeling and whether they need to have a private chat with them.




Positive Agile Teachers (PATs)

- This program is supported by academic research (Dr Mia O'Brian and colleagues at Griffith University).





 PAC is a tool to build our connections and partnerships with groups from a crosssection of our local community.






Pedagogical Practices Explicit Instruction Inquiry
